Week 5 Seashells

Materials

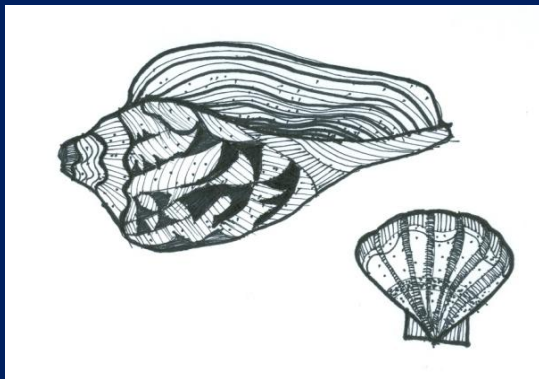
1. An assortment of beautiful Seashells- (Costume and Display, Michael's, or any of the souvenir shops should have them)-Each student can choose one or two to work with individually.
2. Paper suitable for soft pastels, colored pencil or pen and ink
3. Oil Pastels, soft pastels, colored pencils, sharpie pens (I found some that were double ended, so you have a fine point on one end and medium point on the other.)
4. spray fixative

Objectives:

1. To observe detail in nature and learn to recognize symmetrical, asymmetrical, and radial balance.
2. To express a form using varying line weights to create contour (black and white).
3. To explore pastel and colored pencil, creating contour with a combination of blending pastel and delineating with pencil(color)
4. To listen to the ocean and have fun!
